Conditions of Entry

1. Competition will be decided by stroke play over 36 holes played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews.
2. Entries will be limited to seventy two who will play in threes. In the event of applications exceeding 72 the committee will reduce the field by ballot of higher handicap entrants.
3. All entrants must be members of a club affiliated to a National Golf Union, of amateur status and in possession of a recognised handicap certificate not more than 9.
4. Competitors will be made Honorary Members for the day and will be allowed to practice on Friday 16th July from 3.00 p.m. onwards.
5. The committee will make a draw for starting times and each competitor will be notified accordingly.
6. No competitor may take more than one prize (i.e. you cannot win both The Royton Sword and The Anniversary Salver). All ties will be determined by reference to the Rules of The Lancashire Union of Golf Clubs (i.e. all card play offs will be decided on the second round score).
7. The committee reserves the right to refuse entry without giving reasons. All disputes must be referred to the committee for their decision which shall be final.
8. Only entries on the official entry forms and accompanied by the full fee will be accepted. Please enclose a stamped, self addressed envelope.
